Entry/Judging: Friday, April 28. Enter from 3 – 5 p.m. Entry forms will be available. Submit the following information: Name, Age, Address, Phone number, Email, and Cake Name/Theme. Judging will begin at 5 p.m.

Location: The Mack Theater, 114 Main Street, Irvine

Display: Saturday, April 30, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Mushroom Market (white tent) at the corner of Broadway and Court Street. Cakes may be picked up after 5 p.m. on Saturday, but folks really enjoy the cake display and you can leave your cake for the entire weekend. Cakes will be disposed if not picked up by 5 p.m. on Sunday.

Announcement of Winners: Saturday, April 29 at 12:30 p.m. at the Mushroom Market

Categories: Amateur (*One who pursues an activity for pleasure instead of money)

- Child (6 years to 12 years)
- Youth (13 to 17 years)
- Adult (18 years and over)

Theme: Your cake can be decorated in your choice of theme.

Judging:

Entries will be judged on a point system. Criteria are design/creativity, presentation/overall impact and use of mushrooms in the design. Judging will be conducted by a panel of judges selected by the Mountain Mushroom Festival committee. Judges' decisions are final.

Rules:

- The cake must be made and decorated by the person entering the contest. Children (ages 6 – 12) may receive adult assistance with baking the cake, but cake MUST be decorated solely by the child entrant.
- All entries must be on a disposable plate or platter depending on size of cake.
- Cake can be baked or a dummy cake, non-edible props may be used for decoration and structure.
- An index card must be submitted along with the entry providing the Cake Name/Theme. Festival officials will place the cake in the appropriate category.
- There is no entry fee.

Prizes for all age divisions:

All winners in each category will receive a festival rosette, local artisan's handcrafted item, and bragging rights.

- The 1st place winner will receive a blue festival rosette.
- The 2nd place winner will receive a red festival rosette.
- The 3rd place winner will receive a white festival rosette.
